


Find Local Youth on MySpace

If your child uses a social networking site, like *MySpace*, it is suggested that you browse some of the local pages and become familiar with the territory. This will allow you to have credible conversations with your child about its uses, benefits, and abuses.

You can find excellent teaching videos to use with your child about social networking at www.myspace.com/safety. Click on **Safety Videos**.

To quickly browse MySpace pages from the main page:

1. Go to www.myspace.com.
2. Type the child's last name in the box under FIND OR BROWSE MEMBERS.
3. Click GO.
4. Under FILTER RESULTS, simply **enter your zip code**. The box should look like this.
5. Click the UPDATE button. You can link directly to the pages of local youth. Some may be password-protected, but most of them are open for you to view.
